

Useful Instructions on How to apply for project *Machine learning for multimodality image segmentation*

Information useful for completing your application:

1. Ensure that you fulfil the eligibility criteria outlined here:
<http://www.eng.ed.ac.uk/postgraduate/research/projects/machine-learning-multimodality-image-segmentation>
2. All applications must be made using our online system: please do not simply send your CV - we cannot accept applications by email.
3. Since you are applying for a specific project, please note the Research Area *Digital Communications* and the research institute *Institute of Digital Communications*. will be highlighted in the advert.
4. You will need two reference letters
5. You will need to indicate a starting date
6. Documents required (<http://www.eng.ed.ac.uk/postgraduate/research/apply/step-by-step-guide>):
 - a. A completed Application Form - please fill in as much as you can! This is where you will have the opportunity to list any specific projects you would like to apply for.
 - b. Degree certificates and transcripts - originals and English translations if necessary
 - c. Two academic references - on headed paper, signed and dated within the last year
 - d. English Language certificate - for EU/Overseas applicants. [Information on English Language requirements here.](#)

 - e. Research Proposal: our system is automated and will send you an email requesting a Research Proposal. Since you are applying for an advertised project you do not need to provide one but to stop the reminder emails please upload a document which says "Research Proposal not required" and under it list the title of the project.
 - f. CV/List of publications – optional, but recommended particularly if you have relevant publications

Steps:

1. Go to <http://www.ed.ac.uk/studying/postgraduate/degrees/index.php?r=site/view&id=24> this will take you directly to the correct PhD program application page.
2. Read through the general information. Note this position is fully funded.
3. On the right hand side, on the first choice "*PhD Engineering (Digital Communications) - 3 Years (Full-time)*" select a starting date and click apply.
4. Under section 4. *Programme*, heading, *Personal statement*, please describe your fit and interests with respect not only doing a PhD but also the specific project itself.
5. To ensure that the application is considered for this project and is evaluated by the correct supervisor, under section 4. *Programme*, under *research topic*, please include the name of the project. Please repeat the same under *Research project*. Under *project arrangements*, include the name of the supervisor: Dr. Sotirios Tsaftaris.
6. Please ensure that you complete all remaining sections according to the instructions within the relevant page.
